

## **Adams Rib Cook-off Official Rules and Regulations**

1. No 4-wheelers, ATVs, bicycles, golf carts, or motorized vehicles will be allowed Unless authorized.
2. All cookers and equipment must be moved in and in place by Friday April 9, 2010 by 10:00 pm. You will receive your cook-off packet when you register at the cook-off headquarters. If you cannot make it by that time then you need to make arrangements to have someone register and set-up for you.
3. Each team is responsible for clean-up of their own area.
4. Contest meat is NOT to be sampled by the general public or judges prior to judging.
5. No firearms, Gambling, Fighting or Beer Kegs will be allowed in Pfluger Park. Violators will be asked to leave the area and will not be allowed to participate in the activities.
6. Underage drinking will not be tolerated. Minors caught drinking or with an open container will be asked to leave and/or will be ticketed.
7. No swimming pools, reservoirs, etc. will be permitted.
8. The Cook-off Committee shall be the final authority on interpretation of the rules and regulations.
9. The Eden Chamber of Commerce shall not be responsible for any accidents, lost, stolen or damaged property or hurt feelings.
10. NO REFUNDS - RAIN OR SHINE
11. The earliest you may begin setting up in the assigned cooking/camping area is on Friday, April, 9, 2010 between the hours of 12 pm. - 10 pm. Please contact the Chamber of Commerce if you must enter the park any earlier than 12 pm.
12. Contestants must furnish their own brisket, ribs, peppers, pit, wood, etc...
13. Meat must be cooked on site.
14. Decisions of the judges are final.
15. Cooking will begin on April 9, 2010 , turn in for peppers will be 11:30am, turn in for the ribs will be at 12:30 pm and turn in for the briskets will be at 1:30 pm
16. Each entry will be provided a container to turn in. Each container has a double ticket with it, one half is taped to the container and must remain attached. The other half must be kept to claim any winnings. It is very important that you do not lose your ticket. If your box is damaged in any way, tab torn off, dented, etc., you must come to the judging area for a replacement container. Damaged boxes that appear to be marked will not be accepted. Any containers with foil, barbeque sauce, etc. will not be accepted.
17. Ribs – Must be pork spare ribs (no baby backs, no country style). Must turn in eight ribs minimum. No sauces no garnishments.
18. Brisket – Turn in 6 slices minimum. No sauces no garnishments
19. Stuffed Jalapenos – Must use a jalapeno pepper. Turn in eight peppers minimum. Use your imagination on the rest.
20. Have a great time and plan to come back next year.
